Pearl Valley hosted the South African Open from 2007 to 2009. Jack Nicklaus selected this incredible location in the Winelands for his first course in the Western Cape.

After your round you'll visit the highly acclaimed Vrede en Lust Wine Farm. The farm is nestled at the foothills of the Simonsberg in the celebrated Franschhoek Wine Valley. The history of the farm dates back to 1688 and discloses a story of passion and pride.

Taste some of the best wines of the region whilst enjoying the panoramic views of the Simonsberg mountains. Our professional tasting room ambassadors, better known as the Red Ladies, will guide you through our range of wines.

Saturday 1 November: Full day tour of the Cape Peninsula

Enjoy breakfast and meet your guide at reception for a fun-filled day of sightseeing on the Cape Peninsula.

We'll first visit the most south-western point of the African continent – Cape Point, discovered by Portuguese explorer Bartholomeu Dias back in 1488 on his epic voyage to India.

On his return voyage, which must have been particularly stormy, Dias laid anchor at the tip of Africa, and named it *Cabo Tormentoso*, or Cape of Storms.

King John of Portugal later gave it the name *Cabo da Boa Esperança*, or Cape of Good Hope. Today one can hop aboard the funicular and be whisked away on a scenic trip to the view site near the old lighthouse.

Afterwards we'll stop-over in Simon's Town for lunch and a dose of naval history encompassing the Dutch East India Company, the British and South African navies.

On the way back to the hotel you'll visit Boulders, where you'll encounter the famous African Jackass Penguins.

Return to the hotel and freshen up before going out for dinner at any of the excellent restaurants at the Waterfront.
